Our 2021 Rose was harvested early, preserving acidity and allowing a unique combination of complexity and freshness. Soft pink and coral in the glass, this 25% Grenache, 25% Grenache Gris and 50% Syrah blend is brimming with dried white flowers and orange blossom that lead to juicy, prickly, flavors of tangy lemon curd, bright mid-summer peach, and sweet citrus peel. A touch of glycerin broadens the mouthfeel initially but then narrows, feeling focused and taut. It is indulgent, racy, and would serve one well on a lazy day floating the river, or on a sultry evening at a wild costume party.
